Joint Research Funds



Agreements with MX partners support collaborative research projects on specific issues

Proposals submitted by minimum two UC PIs

Active agreements with MX partners:

Short-Term Research Stays



UC graduate students can apply for up to 3 months of funding for research in MX

Call for proposals opens in March for stays running from September through following August

Strategic Research Projects



Applied research on important binational issues engaging non-academic stakeholders

Proposals submitted by a UC PI; collaborators from another UC campus and MX *required*

Call for proposals opens December to March

Projects funded for up to 24 months beginning in September

Latino Studies Projects



Research focused on California Latino, Hispanic, or Chicano communities and ties to MX

Proposals submitted by a UC PI; collaborators from another UC campus *required*

Call for proposals opens June to September

Projects funded for up to 24 months beginning in February

Postdoctoral Research Fellowships



Recent PhD graduates can apply for two-year fellowships at a UC campus w/one year of salary support

Call for proposals opens in September for fellowships beginning in next academic year

Small Grants for Conferences & Travel



Present at a conference in MX or host event at a UC campus

Proposals submitted by a UC PI

Calls for proposals open twice per year:

- Apr-Jun for activities in Fall & Winter
- Oct-Dec for activities in Spring & Summer
