This unique event was part of Expo Transporte 2023, a major annual transportation expo organized by Mexico's National Association of Bus and Truck Manufacturers (ANPACT) in Guadalajara in November. The working group meeting included two panel discussions with experts from the private sector, Mexican and U.S. federal governments, and a binational development bank. It also included the launch of a new strategic research project funded by Alianza MX and led by a team of researchers from the UC Riverside Center for Environmental Research & Technology (CE-CERT).

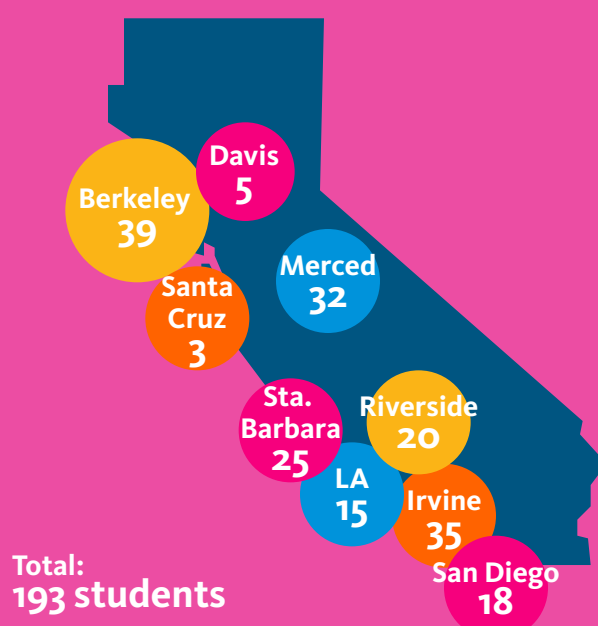
2023 Seed Funding Call for Mobilities to Mexico: Bicentennial Scholars

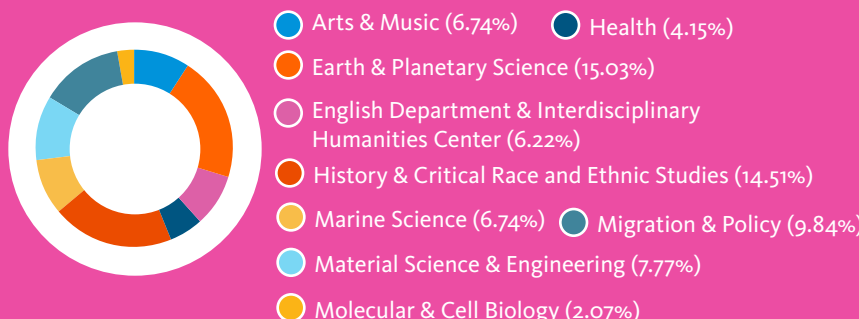
Student Mobility to México by UC Campus
